Job Summary: MECHANIC CLASS "A"

This position is advanced and only routinely supervised. Independent judgment is used while performing all types of maintenance and repair on light, medium and heavy duty buses and support vehicles. Performing thorough inspections of fleet vehicles and completing all documentation of the inspections. Ability to use diagnostic equipment, and to road test vehicles, and to make road calls. Sustained physical endurance for lifting, standing, working with arms extended overhead, climbing, squatting, etc.

This position interacts closely with fellow employees with the department as well as with the Shop Foreman and the Director of Maintenance.

**** This position is classified as a safety-sensitive position in accordance with FTA guidelines 49 CFR 655.4 and must abide by all FTA/DOT guidelines. ****Skills -

Qualifications/ Cross Training; Equipment; Job Location

Education: Prefer High School or equivalent. Must have strong writing skills. Ability to read and follow directions of instructions, department policy, and procedures, EPA and or OSHA guidelines. Must be able to obtain a MS commercial Drivers License Class "B" with a "P endorsement

Experience:

Five years' experience of mechanical repair on Heavy Trucks on Heavy Buses.

Proficient in the repair of air brakes, air systems, air conditioning systems, chassis, electrical system, and gas and diesel engine repair. Have a verifiable work references.

Must be capable of heavy physical work in a fast-moving automotive maintenance garage. The position requires the employee to furnish all needed hand tools up to 1".

Use of diagnostic computer equipment required.

Responsible for D.O.T. self-certification to do annual inspections and brake inspections.

Must pass the company Drug and Alcohol screening test, abide by all drug free work place policies and FTA/DOT guidelines.

Under the FTA guidelines a physical examination must be repeated and passed every two years or sooner as directed by the physician.

Must not have been convicted of any felony involving weapons, narcotics, theft, bodily injury, threatened injury or fatality.

Essential Functions of the job:

- Safely performing all types of maintenance and repairs on light, medium, and heavy duty buses and support vehicles.
- Fill out all check list and documentation when performing a thorough inspection on fleet vehicles.
- Use sophisticated equipment to monitor and diagnose as well as other general automotive tools. These range from computer scanners, bus lifts, floor jacks, hoist, drill press, bench grinders, steam cleaners and cutting torch. A strong background in these and other power tools are needed.

- Operate all vehicles in fleet for road test, delivery and road calls as well as all documentation on each of these jobs.
- Must do annual inspection and brake inspection as required under the self-certification of DOT.
- Organize and clean work area daily before end of shift.

Sustained physical endurance for lifting, standing, working with arms extended overhead, climbing, squatting, etc.
